Our next steps:

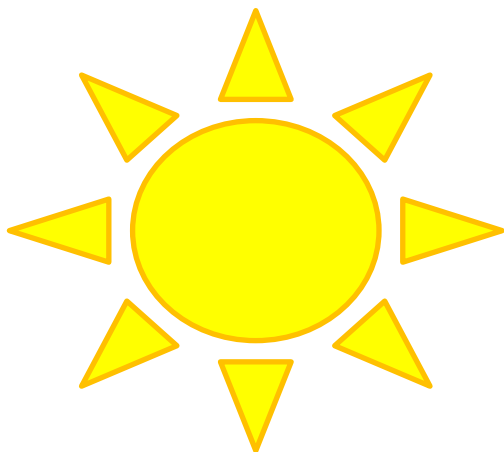
- Purchase some coloured bibs for middle department playground. This will help pupils see their team mates when playing team sports.
